Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Based on Record Review, the Licensee Did Not Comply with the Section Cited Above. Licensee Was Not Able to Provide Proof That Disaster Drills Have Being Conducted at the Facility at Least Every Six Months. This Poses a Potential Health, Safety, or Personal Rights Risk to Children in Care. POC Due Date: 05/10/2024 (1), During the Outdoor Inspection, LPA Observed Two Gates That Lead to an Off-limits Area That Stored Hazardous Foreign Materials, Such as Inoperable Air Condition, Large Woods, Garden Materials, and Metal Fences. LPA Observe That the Infants Have Access to Those Hazardous Foreign Materials. This Poses a Potential Health, Safety, or Personal Rights Risk to Children in Care.
