LPA's Also Observed a School Age Child Napping with Preschool Children; Therefore Commingling Was Observed and This Is an Immediate Risk to Children. Form LIC 9224 Was Given and Discussed at Time of Inspection. POC Due Date: 04/07/2022 (2), Based on Record Review, the Licensee Did Not Comply with the Section Cited Above in That There Were 2 Fully Qualified Staff and 4 Aides Supervising 56 Kids Which Includes 49 Preschool and 7 School Kids Which Poses an Immediate Health, Safety or Personal Rights Risk to Persons in Care. POC Due Date: 02/15/2023 (1), and Based on LPA Owens Observation the Licensee Did Not Comply with the Section Cited Above in That There Were Three Children Observed Coming From the Bathroom Not Escorted by Staff; Children Were in Bathroom Alone and Returned to Classroom by Themselves Which Poses an Immediate Health, Safety or Personal Rights Risk to Persons in Care.
