Due to There Being No LIC9227s on File, LPAs Could Not Verify That Children Could Roll of Their Own Accord and That They Were Not Placed on Their Stomachs by Staff Which Poses an Immediate Health, Safety or Personal Rights Risk to Persons in Care. POC Due Date: 04/21/2023 (1) and Based on Record Review, the Facility Did Not Comply with the Section Cited Above as LPAs Noticed That on One of the Child Supervision Records (CSRs) a Staff Member Had Noted That on 01/04/2023 the Toddlers Classroom, Which Serves Ages 6 Months to 2 Years per the Director, Was Overcapacity with 5 Children Left Alone with One Teacher Which Poses an Immediate Health, Safety or Personal Rights Risk to Persons in Care.
