Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were Failure of a Licensee to Maintain and Provide to OSSE Upon Request, the Information for Each Currently Enrolled Child: (1), Failure of Licensee to Maintain a Qualified Workforce Comprised of Individuals Who Are Committed to Promoting and Ensuring the Health, Safety, and Welfare of the Children in Their Care. (1), and Children Shall Not Be Left Alone in Any Room, Outdoors, or in Vehicles, Even Momentarily, Without Staff Present (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
