Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Failure of a Licensee to Immediately Notify OSSE of Any Unusual Incident That May Adversely Affect the Health, Safety, or Welfare of Any Enrolled Child or Children by Submitting a Completed OSSE Unusual Incident Report Form to OSSE's Child Care Complaint Email Address. (1), Failure of a Licensee to Ensure That the Temperature Within Each Room of Program Space Shall Be Maintained at Between Sixty-eight Degrees Fahrenheit (68°F) and Seventy-five Degrees Fahrenheit (75°F) From October Through March, and Between Sixty-eight Degrees Fahrenheit (68°F) and Eighty-two Degrees Fahrenheit (82°F) From April Through September. (1), and Failure to Operate a Licensed Child Development Facility in Accordance with the License Capacity, Age Range Limitations, Hours of Operation and Other Specific Service Requirements or Restrictions Designated on Its License (1).
