Ensure fire extinguisher is mounted. Monthly inspection is complete.

● **Sleeping Accommodations and Safe Sleep Environments**

35P

Ensure safe sleep practices. Bassinettes or side sleepers are prohibited. Must be crib, pack-n-play, or playpen.
