Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Room Main 300-Van Gogh There Were 29 Children Present, 12 Three Year Olds and 17 Four Year Olds with Three Staff Which Is Above the Maximum Capacity of 25. (1), 591-1-1-.08(6) Requires the Center to Maintain Records of a Child's Daily Arrival and Departure for the Twelve (12) Preceding Months That the Parent or Person(s) Authorized by the Parent Documents, in Written or Electronic Format, Each Time the Parent or Authorized Person Drops Off and Picks Up the Child. The Documentation Shall Include at Least the Date, the Child's Name, the Arrival and Departur (1), and 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)3. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Document in Writing the Date and Time of Arrival and Departure Each Time the Vehicle Departs From the Center, Is Loaded or Unloaded at Each School and When the Vehicle Returns to the Center (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
