Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Playground Observed to Be Clean and in Good Repair on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Thro (2), 591-1-1-.36(7)(c) Requires the Center to Use Passenger Transportation Checklists, in a Format Approved by the Department, to Account for Each Child During Transportation. A Separate Passenger Checklist Must Be Used for Each Vehicle.
