Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined That the Homes Back Step Leading to the Playground Had a Splintered Board and Was Not in Good Repair as Required. (1), 290-2-3-.07(9)(b)1 Requires the Annual Ten (10) Clock Hours of Training Shall Include at Least Two (2) Hours in Evidence Based, Developmentally Appropriate Language and Literacy Practices. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That the Home Did Not Have Evidence of the Required Language and Literacy Training.
