Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1), 591-1-1-.25(7) Requires That Doors to Rooms Not Approved for Child Care, Other Than the Kitchen Doors, Be Latched or Locked So Children Cannot Wander Into Those Areas. Except in School-age Centers, Interior Center Door Locks Shall Permit Personnel to Open the Locked Room From Outside of the Room in an Emergency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Door to a Utility Room and the Laundry (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route.
