Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Potentially Hazardous Items Were Stored Accessible to Children: -Room A- a Pair of Adult Scissors in a Container on a Shelf, a Package of Wipes on the Sink -Room C- a Book Bag with Ointments and Lotion O (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-.18(1) Requires That Food Be in Sound Condition, Free From Spoilage and Contamination and Safe for Human Consumption. Eggs, Pork, Pork Products, Poultry and Fish Shall Be Thoroughly Cooked. All Raw Fruits and Vegetables Shall Be Washed Thoroughly Before Being Cooked or Served. Foods Not Subject to Further Washing or Cooking Before Serving Shall Be Stored in Such a Manner as to Be Protected (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
