Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1), Please Secure Cleaning Tools (I.e., Broom, Plunger) Out of Reach of Children. Finding 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Classroom Main D-2L-4's and ASP Classroom a Toilet Bowl Brush Was Left Accessible to Children in the Bathroom. Additionally, Bab (1), and Please Ensure Lids Remain on Trash Containing Organic Waste. Comment Proper Hand Washing Observed Throughout the Center on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.17(6) Requires Garbage and Organic Waste to Be Stored in Containers That Are Lined with Plastic Liners and Have Tight-fitting Covers. Trash and Garbage Shall Be Removed From the Building Daily or as Often as Necessary to Maintain the Premises in a C (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
