Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.10(6) Requires the Home to Provide a Menu Listing All Meals and Snacks to Be Served During the Current Week. Substitutions Shall Be Recorded on the Posted Menu. Menus Shall Be Retained at the Home for Six (6) Months. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Provider Did Not Have a Menu for the Current Week and Writes the Menu Daily on White Board by the Stairs. (2) and 290-2-3-.11(2)(a) Requires the Home to Have a Written Plan for Handling Emergencies, Including but Not Limited to Fire, Severe Weather, Loss of Electrical Power or Water, and Death, Serious Injury or Loss of a Child, a Threatening Event, or Natural Disaster Which May Occur at the Home. The Home Will Have in Place Procedures for Evacuation, Relocation, Shelter-in-place, Lock-down, Communication And (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
