Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), Consultant Requested to View All Criminal Record Checks for Employees Hired After Last Visit. Director Stated That There Have Been No New Hires Since Last Visit Finding 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints (1), and 591-1-1-.14(2) Requires a Staff Member Who Is Trained in CPR and First Aid to Be on the Premises and on Any Field Trip Whenever Any Child Is Present. In Addition, Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Satisfactorily Obtain Certification in First Aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if Employed Prior to September 30, 2016 and Within 90 Days of Their Hire Date if Employed After September 30, 20 (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
