Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Multiple Holes in the Ground Were Located Through Out the Yard. A Hose Was Located Within the Play Area and Accessible. (1) and 290-2-3-.11(1)(n) Requires Pets in the Home Be Properly Vaccinated in Accordance with the Requirements of the Local County Boards of Health.
