### 3 Inspection Visits Since 2025 - 5 Findings

● 5 Important

Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.07(2) Requires That Parents Be Immediately Notified and Specific Instructions Obtained Until the Child Can Be Picked Up or Returned to the Group, Immediately When Professional Medical Attention Is Required, or When the Child Experiences Symptoms of Moderate Discomfort, or When the Child Is Involved in an Incident That Puts Their Health And/or Safety at Risk A (1), and Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.36(10) Requires That a Child Never Be Left Unattended in a Vehicle. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation and Self-report That on December 2, 2025, One Staff Member Transported 13 School-aged Children in the Center's Vehicle to Local Elementary Schools. A 7-year-old Child Remained Unattended on the Vehicle for Approximately 55 Minutes After Falling Asle (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
