Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(1)(e) Prohibits the Use of Multiple Plugs and Electric Extension Cords. Electrical Outlets Within Reach of Children Shall Be Plugged or Covered. It Was Determined Based on Observation That One Electrical Outlet Located Above the Red Plastic Child's Table and Chairs Did Not Have a Protective Covering. (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months.
