Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.18(6) Requires That Non-disposable Dishes, Glasses and Silverware Are Properly Cleaned by Pre-rinsing, or Scraping, Washing, Sanitizing and Air Drying. A Three (3) Compartment Sink or a Dishwasher with a Sani-cycle or Capability of Maintaining a Rinse Water Temperature of a Minimum of One Hundred Fifty (150) Degrees Fahrenheit and a Two (2) Compartment Sink Shall (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), and 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Shall Immediately Document in Writing, with a Check or Other Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed on the Passenger Transportation Checklist Each Time a Child Enters and Exits the Vehicle. The Driver or Other Designated Staff Person Shall Document in Writing with a Different Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
