Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (2), 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way as to Be Free of Rust And (2), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children.
