Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Comment 591-1-1-.26(3) - Please Ensure the Wooden Planks on the Path to the Playground Are Secured to Prevent Tripping Hazards. (1), Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures. Finding 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1).(b) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Director Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
