The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours. The Training Must Address the Following Health and Safety Topics: A)prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Including Immu (2), Paperwork, Checklist, Permission Forms, Annual Inspection Form and Proper Check of the Vehicle After Transportation Were Discussed with the Director. Finding 591-1-1-.36(4)(a) Requires an Annual Safety Check for Each Vehicle.
