Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Green Wire Was Hanging Low Above the Play Area. Also There Was a Fence Behind the Playground Fence Leaning Into the P (1). The single finding was not critical.
