Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Please Be Mindful to Keep Items That Pose a Hazard Inaccessible to Children. Comment Please Secure Cleaning Tools (I.e., Broom, Plunger) Out of Reach of Children. Finding 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Single 1st Left Two Drawers Were Left Unloc (2), 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Main Middle Left Four Infants Had Bibs Around Their Necks While Playing on the Floor and Bouncing in a Bouncer. Additionally, Two Infants Had Pacifier Attachments Connected to Their Bibs While Playing O (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) - Please Continue to Monitor the Bottom of the Metal Fencing for Gaps. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
