Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(6) Requires the Center to Maintain Records of a Child's Daily Arrival and Departure for the Twelve (12) Preceding Months That the Parent or Person(s) Authorized by the Parent Documents, in Written or Electronic Format, Each Time the Parent or Authorized Person Drops Off and Picks Up the Child. The Documentation Shall Include at Least the Date, the Child's Name, the Arrival and Departur (1), 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way as to Be Free of Rust And (1), and 591-1-1-.15(3) Requires Baby Bottles and Formula to Be Labeled with the Individual Child's Name (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
