Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Seven Children Present in the Main B Classroom That Is Limited to Six Children to Meet the 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child Requirement. (2), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the Main A Classroom There Was a Plastic Pull Ups Bag in One Child's Bag in Their Cubby, Accessible to Children and in the Main B Classroom There Were Pull Ups Bag Accessible to Children in the Bottom of the Cubbie (1), and 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Thorny Vines Present Along the Ground and the Blue Rack on Both Playgrounds. Additionally, Tall Weeds and Grass Were Present on the Main Playground A. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
