Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classrooms A and B Exceeded the Licensed Capacity. Classroom A Was Observed with Nine Children, and Classroom B Was Also Observed with Nine Children. (2), 591-1-1-.14(1)(a) Requires All Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Obtain Certification in a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Within the First 45 Days of Employment.
