Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That 15 Children Were Observed in Main B (2R) 3-12 Yrs. The License Capacity for This Classroom Was 14. (1), 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Main A -(1R) 1's & 2's Classroom Ther (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
