Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(11) Requires That Floor Coverings Be Tight, Smooth, Free of Odors and Washable or Cleanable. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Flooring at the Back Left, Back Middle, and Back Right of Classroom B- 6 wks-18 Mths Was Not Smooth and Had Sharp Protruding Corners, Causing a Potential Tripping and Cutting Hazard. It Was Further Determined That the Ramp at the Back of Classroom (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-.15(3) Requires Baby Bottles and Formula to Be Labeled with the Individual Child's Name (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom B- 6wks- 18mths Did Not Have a Ventilation Fan As**
