Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on Observat (1), 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Staff #6 with a Hire Date of September 1, 2024 Did Not Submit Both a Records Check Appl (1), and 591-1-1-.14(1) Requires the Center Director And, at Any Given Time, at Least Fifty Percent (50%) of the Caregiver Staff to Successfully Complete a Biennial Training Program in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in First Aid. The First Aid Training Must Be Done by Certified or Licensed Health Care Professionals or Trainers and Must Deal with the Provision of Emerge (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
