Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) - Consultant Discussed with Director to Ensure That the Animal Excrement Is Removed From the Outside Play Area. (2), 290-2-3-.11(1)(j) Requires Children's Hands to Be Washed with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water: Immediately Upon Arrival for the Day and Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play (2), and 290-2-3-.10(3) - Consultant Discussed with the Provider That the Signed Written Feeding Plan for Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Updated Regularly as New Foods Are Added or Other Dietary Changes Are Made and the Feeding Plan Shall Be Posted in the Main Child Care Area.
