Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.33(5)(b)1. Requires the Annual Ten (10) Clock Hours of Training Shall Include at Least Two (2) Hours in Evidence Based, Developmentally Appropriate Language and Literacy Practices. It Was Determined Based on Observation That 4 Out of 10 Center Staff Did Not Have at Least (2) Hours of Evidence Based, Developmentally Appropriate Language and Literacy Practices for the Following Staff Member (2), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazardous Materials and Supplies Were Accessible to Children in the Following Classrooms: - Room 101: Cleaning Product Clear Storage Bin in the Entrance of the Classroom and Plastic Bags Containing Blank (1), and Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface.
