Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records and Observation That Staff Member #7 Was Present in Classroom C with Six Children and No Other Staff Members Without Eviden (1), 591-1-1-.03(6) Requires Center Staff to Ensure Children Less Than Three Years of Age Do Not Spend More Than One-half Hour of Time Consecutively in Confining Equipment, Such as Swings, Highchairs, Jump Seats, Carriers or Walkers. Children Shall Use Such Equipment Only When They Are Awake. Such Children Shall Be Allowed Time to Play on the Floor Daily. Infants Shall Have Supervised Tummy Time on The (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
