Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined, Based on Staff Statements and Interviews, That the Allegation on May 10, 2024, a Two-year-old Child Was Picked Up From the Program with a Soiled Diaper That Had Not Been Changed All Day Is Substantiated. There Is a Preponderance of Evidence to Suppo (1), and 591-1-1-.14(1) Requires the Center Director And, at Any Given Time, at Least Fifty Percent (50%) of the Caregiver Staff to Successfully Complete a Biennial Training Program in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in First Aid. The First Aid Training Must Be Done by Certified or Licensed Health Care Professionals or Trainers and Must Deal with the Provision of Emerge (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
