Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined, Based on Observation, That Four Out of Four Pieces of Climbing Equipment on the Playground Had Approximately One Inch in Depth of Resilient Surfacing in the Fal (1), 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Diaper Changing Surface in Classroom M (1), and 591-1-1-.20(1) Requires Personnel to Obtain Specific Written Authorization From the Child's Physician or Parent in Order to Dispense Prescription or Non-prescription Medications, Except for First Aid. Such Authorization Will Include When Applicable, Date (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
