Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.15(5) Requires That the Center Provide a Menu Listing All Meals and Snacks to Be Served During the Current Week Except for School-age Centers Where the Food May Be Provided by the Parent(s) by Agreement Between the School-age Center and the Parent(s). Substitutions Shall Be Recorded on the Posted Menu and Menus Shall Be Retained at the Center for Six (6) Months. It Was Determined Based On (2), 591-1-1-.10(3) Requires Center Staff to Change Diapers in the Child's Own Crib or on a Diaper Changing Surface That Is Used for No Purposes Other Than Changing Diapers and Other Clothing in Each Room Where Infants or Any Other Children Wearing Diapers Are Served. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Diaper Changing Pad Had Cracks Throughout the Center of the Pad. (1), and 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
