Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(8)(b) Requires the Provider, a Provisional Employee or Employee with Current Evidence of Successful Completion of Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Must Always Be on the Home's Premises Whenever Any Child Is Present. It Was Determined Based on Review of Staff Records and the Providers Statement That the CPR and Pediatric First Aid Expired April 1, 20 (2) and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
