Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight- Fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two Out of Three Crib Sheets Were Not Tight- Fitting While in Use in the Main Classroom. (1), 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Tipping Hazards Were Accessible to Children on This Date: - There Was an Unsecured White Wooden Bookshelf on the Front Right Side of the Main Classroom - There Were Two B (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
