Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(4) Requires That Children Under Three Years Old Be Housed in Separate Physical Areas From Older Children and Cannot Be Mixed with Older Children Except at Specified Times and Circumstances. It Was Determined Based on Observation Classroom A-Downstairs Back Had Two Staff Present with Eleven Children Who Ages Ranged From 2-year- Olds to 4-year-olds. Consultant Observed Two 2-year-olds, E (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children.
