Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation in Classroom C 1L Upper the Cabinet Underneath the Sink Is Unlocked with Two Containers of Aerosol Disinfectant Spray Inside Accessible to Children. (2), Trees Located on the Site or That Encroach Onto the Site From Adjacent Properties May Have Structural Issues That Present an Elevated Level of Risk. Consider Having These Trees Inspected by a Certified Arborist to Determine Their Structural Integrity and Associated Levels of Risk.
