Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Potentially Hazardous Items Were Observed: Classroom B: - Wipes and Gloves Were Observed in the Children's Cubbies. - A Roll of Plastic Bags Was Observed Under the Diaper Changing Table in an Unlocked Ca (2) and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2). None of the 4 findings were critical.
