Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Potentially Hazardous Items Were Accessible: * Room A- (1) 3-6 Years Old - A Floor Tower Fan Was Stored at Low Level Next to the Door, but Was Not Plugged In, which Also Posed a Tripping Hazard. * Room B- (2), Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute Especially After Rainfall. Finding 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children.
