It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Items Were Stored Accessible to Children: - a Container of Clorox Wipes, a Package of Baby Wipes on a High Chair, One Balloon in the Play Area (3) and 290-2-3-.21(1)(m)3. Requires That a New Comprehensive Records Check Determination Be Completed for the Provider and Each Employee and Provisional Employee at Least Once Every Five Years. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That Staff Person #1 Did Not Have a New Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File. A One Day Letter Was Left. (1).
