Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.06(4) Requires a Center First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Remodel or Add to Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have the Bathroom Area Fully Enclosed and Ventilated to the Outside of the Building with Either an Open Screened Window or Functioning Exhaust Fan and Duct System and Requires Centers Without Fully Enclosed Bathrooms to Ensure There Is Adequate Ventilation to Con (2), 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route.
