Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.15(1) Requires That Meals and Snacks Are Served, with Serving Sizes Dependent Upon the Age of the Child, That Meet Nutritional Guidelines as Established by the United States Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program. Meals and Snacks Shall Be Varied Daily, and Additional Servings of Nutritious Food Shall Be Offered to Children Over and Above the Required Daily Minimum, I (1), 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Diapering Pads in Room 6 and Room 7 We (1), and 591-1-1-.17(6) Requires Garbage and Organic Waste to Be Stored in Containers That Are Lined with Plastic Liners and Have Tight-fitting Covers. Trash and Garbage Shall Be Removed From the Building Daily or as Often as Necessary to Maintain the Premises in a Clean Condition. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the Restroom Between Room 6 and Room 7 a Disguarded Pull-up Was in an Uncovered (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
