Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That an Infant Had a Pacifier Clip Attached to Their Clothing in Classroom A 1R. (1), The Vehicle Had an Approved Fire Extinguisher and First Aid Kit on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.36(7)(b) Requires That an Emergency Medical Information Record Be Maintained in the Vehicle for Each Child Being Transported. The Emergency Medical Information Record for Each Child Shall Include a Listing of the Child's Full Name, Date of Birth, Allergies, Special Medical Needs and Conditions, Current P (1), and 591-1-1-.20(1) Requires Personnel to Obtain Specific Written Authorization From the Child's Physician or Parent in Order to Dispense Prescription or Non-prescription Medications, Except for First Aid. Such Authorization Will Include When Applicable, Date (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
