Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Complete First Aid Kits Observed in Center and on Vehicles. Finding 591-1-1-.14(2) Requires a Staff Member Who Is Trained in CPR and First Aid to Be on the Premises and on Any Field Trip Whenever Any Child Is Present. In Addition, Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Satisfactorily Obtain Certification in First Aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if Employed Prior to September 30, 2016 And (2), 591-1-1-.33(3) Requires Each Staff Member with Direct Care Responsibilities to Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours. The Training Must Address the Following Health and Safety Topics: Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Including Immunizations (1), and Please Ensure to Monitor Toys and Equipment for Normal Wear and Tear. Finding 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Television Was Not Secured to a Tan Bookshelf Located in the Block Area on the Back-left Side of Classro (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
