Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation One Child in Classroom 1R-B-Back Right Had a Pacifier Attached to Their Clothing and Another Child Had a Bib Around Their Neck, During Play Time, at the Time of the Visit. (1), 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom 1R-B-Back Right Had 3 of 5 Crib with Loose Fitting Sheets at the Time of the Visit. (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported Electronically. A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
