Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a a Teacher's Purse Was Stored on Cots and Baby Wipes Were Stored on a Shelf in the Bathroom in Room A. It Was Further Determined That a Pair of Adult Scissors Was Stored in an Unlocked Cabinet in Room D. (2), 591-1-1-.03(1) Requires the Center to Provide a Daily Planned Program of Varied and Developmentally Appropriate Activities to Promote Social, Emotional, Physical, Cognitive, Language and Literacy Growth. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Three PVC Border Pipes That Were Detached Along the Bottom of the Fence Which Posed a Potential Tripping or Entrapment Hazard. (1).
