Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined That Diaper Cream, Powder and Diaper Wipes That Were Marked "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Were Stored in Unlocked Diaper Changing Tables and Were Accessible to Children in Classroom C. (2), 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That Staff # 14 with Hire Date of January 30,2022 Had Expired Fingerprints with a Da (1), and Discussed Adding Equipment and Toys to Enhance Variety. Finding 591-1-1-.12(5) Requires Center Staff to Provide Table Space for Each Child Who Is Able to Sit at a Table Unassisted and an Appropriately Sized Chair or Bench for Each Child Who Is Not an Infant and Who Is Able to Use a Chair or Bench. It Was Determined That Classroom D Did Not Have Adequate Table Space and Appropriately Sized Chairs O (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
