Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in T (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.15(7) Requires That Food Be Served According to Manufacturer's Instructions and Recommendations.
